- 1. Click the Accounts tab at the top of the Windows Live Mail screen.

  - A. Your full email address
  - B. Password for the email account.
  - C. Your name as you would like it displayed to message recipients.
  - D. Check to Manually configure server settings.

- 6. Enter your full email address into the Logon User Name box.
- 7. Click **Next** and **Finish** on the screen that follows.
